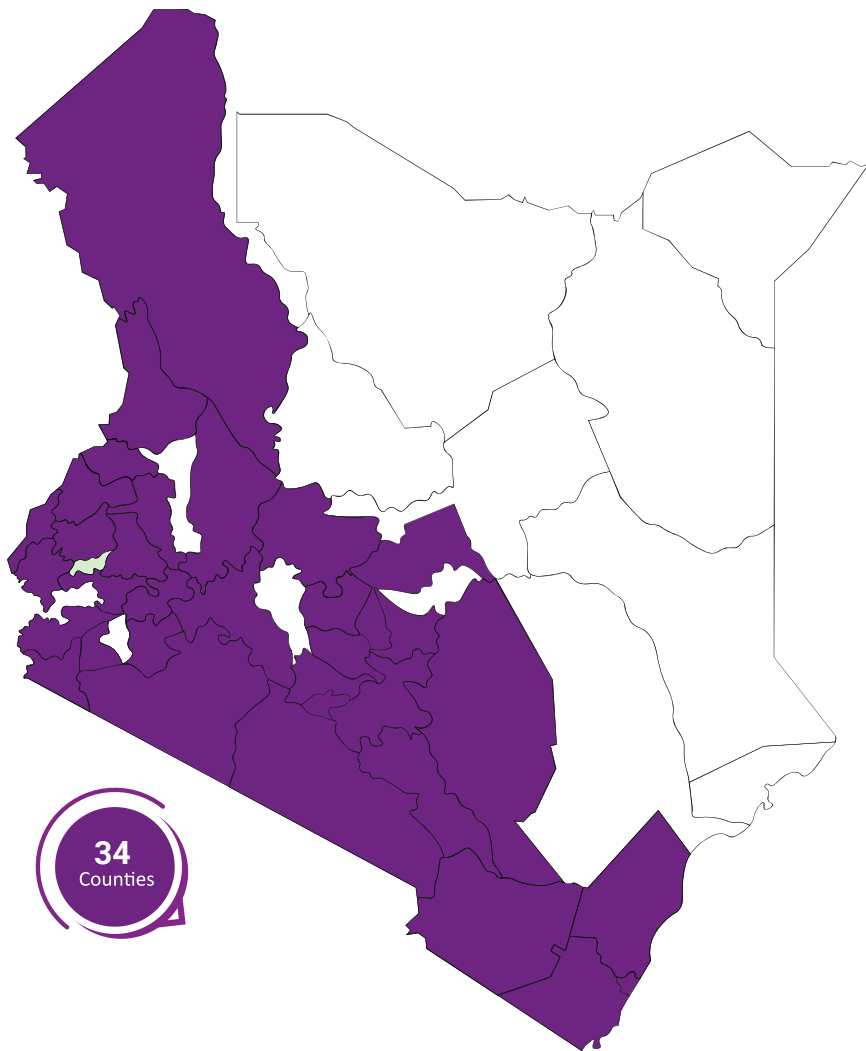

Mombasa, Kilifi, Kwale and Taita Taveta).



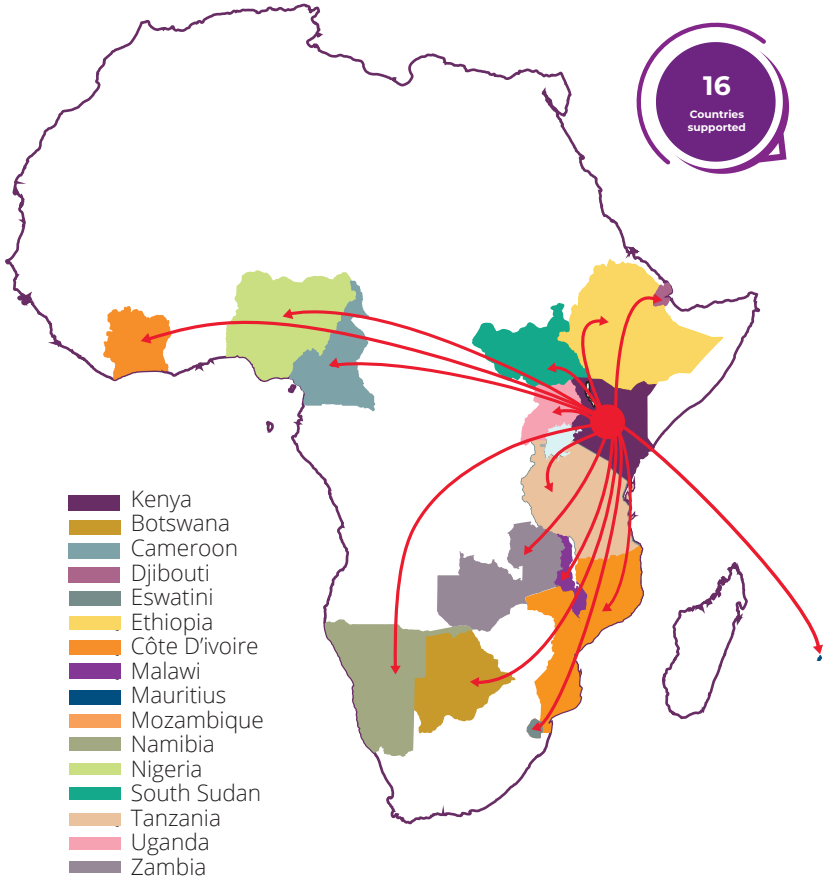

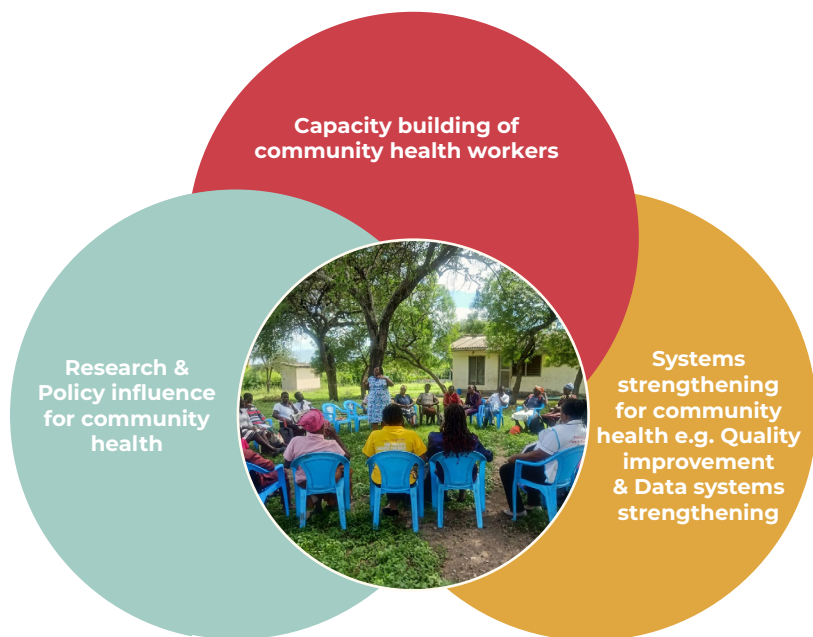
# Health Systems Strengthening

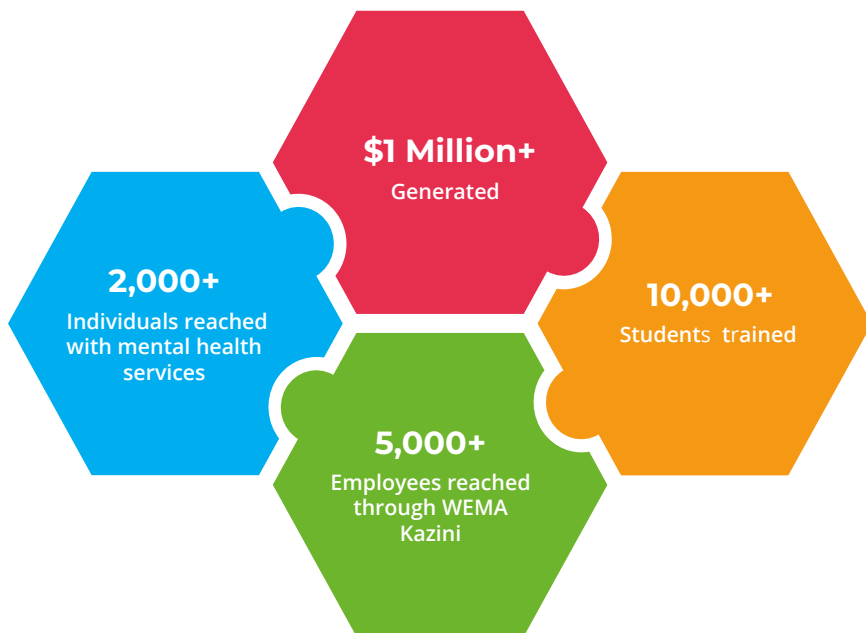
