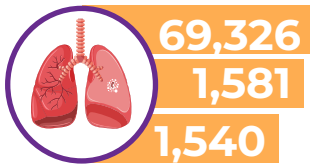

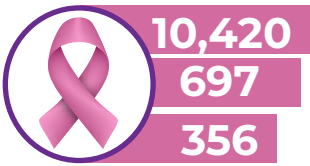

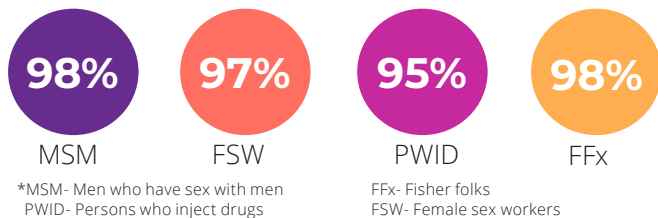

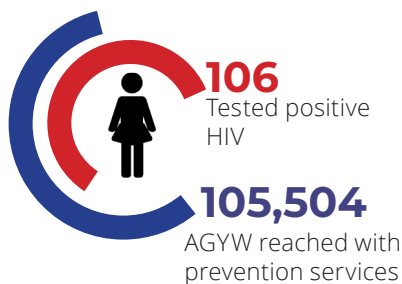

LVCT Health implements the DREAMS (Determined, Resilient, Empowered, AIDS-free, Mentored and Safe) program to empower vulnerable adolescent girls and young women between the ages of 10 and 24 with the knowledge and skills to make healthy choices and remain HIV-free. The DREAMS program was implemented in Nairobi, Kiambu, Migori and Homa Bay counties.

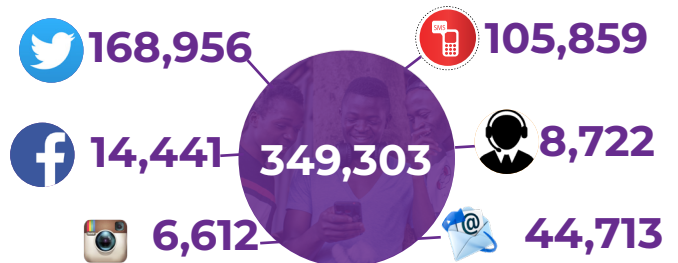

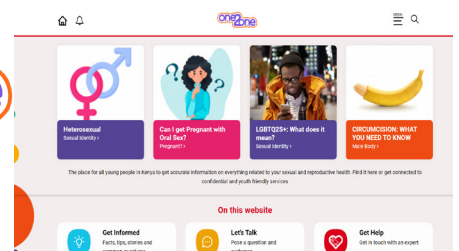
