LVCT Health offered technical support to Mombasa County to develop the first Adolescent and Young People Strategy on HIV and Sexual and Reproductive Health.

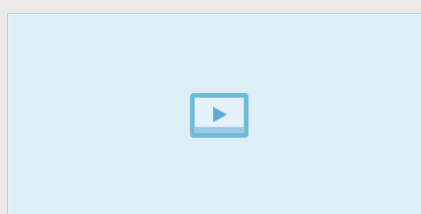
