LVCT Health is a Kenyan NGO that utilizes research to inform policy reform advocacy and strengthen HIV service delivery with special attention to vulnerable groups and populations with special needs.

DEVELOPMENT OF YOUTH ADVISORY CHAMPIONS FOR HEALTH (YACH) TRAINING CURRICULUM

BACKGROUND

In 2018 LVCT Health received funds to implement programs aimed at adolescents and young persons aged 10-24. The funds were received from UNICEF to implement the 'Most at Risk Adolescents and young persons' (MARA) project and Frontline AIDS to implement the 'Partnership to Inspire Transform and Connect the HIV response' (PITCH project).

OBJECTIVES

- Developing capacities of adolescents and young persons to meaningfully participate in programming.
- Policy advocacy on issues of HIV and SRHR in supported counties of Nairobi, Kiambu, Mombasa, Kilifi, Migori and Homa Bay.

RATIONALE

LVCT Health has been undertaking implementing the two projects and has developed various training materials aimed to create and strengthen the capacity of the Youth Advisory Champions for Health (YACH) in the supported counties. Despite the availability of the training materials there is a lack of a standardized curriculum to structure the delivery of content.

SPECIFIC AIMS

1. Review project documents for understanding of the goals and objectives.
2. Review the existing materials on different components including peer education, life skills, services delivery and policy advocacy.
3. Identify best practices in approaches for capacity building of community level organizations.
4. Develop a five days training curriculum, including the relevant reference materials and handouts.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

This consultancy is meant to develop a complete curriculum in line with best practices of mixed learners who are young adults. The consultant will therefore be expected to deliver:

- Facilitators' Manual
- Participants' Manuals
- Reference materials
- Handouts



DURATION OF ENGAGEMENT

It is expected that the evaluation will be carried out in 30 days.

METHODOLOGY

The Consultant should furnish LVCT Health with an appropriate methodology and delivery plan that they propose to use to develop the training package.

CONSULTANT SPECIFICATIONS

The consultants should have substantial knowledge in HIV and SRHR programming for adolescents and young persons (AYP), Policy advocacy at National and County levels, Peer-led health service delivery and health service delivery systems in public health facilities and at community level.

This consultancy is open to **individuals and consultancy firms** who meet the following requirements:

- A clear understanding of the facility and community based HIV and SRH services in Kenya
- Understanding of HIV programming for AYP
- Experience in development of curricula
- Experience in training, including community based groups
- Knowledge of rights-based health delivery approach and advocacy
- Capacity to gather and critically analyse information

QUALIFICATION OF THE CONSULTANT

- Post-graduate degree in public health, social sciences or other relevant field
- At least five years' hands-on experience in developing curricula
- Excellent research, analytical report writing skills
